





Discover Cape Cod on a charming tour with stops in bustling Boston, colonial Plymouth, Martha's Vineyard, quaint Nantucket Island, Newport, and Providence.

## DAY 1: FLY TO BOSTON

Upon arrival, we check-in to our hotel in Boston.

## DAY 2: THE PURITAN CITY

We start the morning with a tour of Fenway Park. You'll get to learn about the Boston Red Sox, the ballpark, and player history. A local guide joins us for a comprehensive Boston city tour as we witness some of the city's oldest buildings and neighborhoods as well as its most iconic contemporary features. Our city tour concludes at the historic Faneuil Hall Marketplace

where we'll stop for lunch. We depart The Puritan City and make our way to Plymouth where we follow in the footsteps of the first settlers. To begin, we explore a reproduction of the *Mayflower* and see Plymouth Rock. Enjoy an included dinner overlooking the waterfront and check-in for a two-night stay in Plymouth. **B,D**

## DAY 3: PLYMOUTH

This morning we kick off our day with a visit to the Plimoth Plantation where we encounter the Wampanoag People and Colonial communities of the

1600s, providing us with engaging in-and-outdoor learning experiences to educate and tell surprising stories of the intersection between English and Indigenous cultures in the 17th century. Immerse yourself in "The Museum of Thanksgiving" as we all commemorate the famous 1621 feast with an included "Eat like a Pilgrim" lunch featuring turkey, sweet Indian corn pudding, pompion (squash), fruit, cheese, and apple cider. After lunch, spend time exploring the Pilgrim Hall Museum, the oldest continuously operating public museum in the

country. This museum houses an extraordinary collection of 17th century artifacts, some from the actual *Mayflower*. Before dinner, we stop at the Plimoth Grist Mill where the milling process for various grains is a public spectacle. **B,L**

## DAY 4: MARTHA'S VINEYARD

Today, we travel to Cape Cod to catch the ferry to Martha's Vineyard and tour the affluent summer colony with its colorful gingerbread houses, coastal communities, and breathtaking Aquinnah cliffs. After a lovely day on the island, we'll return to Cape Cod where we'll check-in to our accommodations for the next three nights.

## DAY 5: PROVINCETOWN

After breakfast, we head to the northern tip of the cape for an exciting day in Provincetown. For May through September departures, go on a whale watching cruise for glimpses of humpback whales, birds, dolphins, and sharks. As the seasons turn, the whales travel south. Since this is also during the height of the cranberry harvest, our October departure will instead visit a bog to learn all about cranberries. After lunch, we visit the Pilgrim Monument and Provincetown Museum which honors the Pilgrims' first landing in

Provincetown. At this site in the 17th century, Pilgrims explored the tip of Cape Cod for five weeks and established rules for the "new" land in the *Mayflower Compact*. This evening has us rolling through the wavy, oceanfront dunes of the Peaked Hill Bars Historic District where artists have famously found inspiration since the 1920s. Catch sights of Pilgrim Lake and watch for the historic dune shack homes of American writers and artists. Dinner tonight is a real treat; a classic New England Clambake and beach BBQ (weather permitting). Our beautiful sunset dune tour with dinner prepared by local Provincetown restaurants makes for a memorable adventure! **B,D**

## DAY 6: NANTUCKET

Board the ferry this morning to explore the quaint, timeless island of Nantucket. This tiny coastal town preserves its aesthetic down to its signature New England cottages and manicured beaches. We'll visit the Nantucket Whaling Museum that showcases nine galleries filled with artifacts telling stories of the island's past four centuries. Following, we'll go on an island tour and get the full Nantucket experience. You will have time to explore on your own and grab lunch before we ferry back to the cape. Enjoy an included

dinner tonight as we gather at the Sea Dog Brew Pub. **B,D**

## DAY 7: PROVIDENCE

Our last full day takes us across the border into Rhode Island where we begin the day with a visit to The Breakers Mansion, the original Newport summer house of Cornelius Vanderbilt II. Take time to venture through the 70-room 125,000+ square foot "cottage" that perfectly embodies the iconic Vanderbilt family's massive social and financial influence and status at the turn of the last century. Enjoy lunch on your own in Newport before we travel to Providence and embark on a leisurely, educational, and fun exploration of the city's waterways. Tonight, we come together for a Holiday Vacations Farewell Dinner. **B,D**

## DAY 8: FLY HOME

Fly home with lovely memories from Boston, Cape Cod, and Rhode Island.







# General Information

## Guaranteed Prices

Holiday Vacations' published tour prices are based on the rates known at the time of publication and are expected to be in effect at the time of departure. Once we have received your deposit, your price is guaranteed and any subsequent price increase is at our expense.

## Reservations

Make reservations well in advance. Space requested by phone will be held for five business days pending receipt of the required deposit by mail, telephone or in person. Reservations made after the indicated final payment due date must be paid in full at the time of reservation.

## \$200 Deposit Per Person

A deposit must accompany all reservation requests. Personal check, money order, Discover, MasterCard or VISA are acceptable forms of payment.

## Final Payment

A balance due date and amount will be indicated on your tour statement. We accept credit cards but appreciate final payments to be made by check or money order.

## Refunds

Deposits and all payments are fully refundable prior to the final payment due date. Holiday Vacations issues refunds via the payment method they were provided. (e.g., payments provided by check will be refunded with a check; payments provided by credit card will be refunded to that credit card.)

## Special Requests

Individual requests must be made when booking. Requests for (non) smoking, special dietary needs, adjoining, handicap accessible or other room types are subject to confirmation and cannot be guaranteed.

## Hazardous Materials

Federal law forbids the carriage of hazardous materials aboard aircraft in your luggage or on your person. A violation can result in five years imprisonment and penalties of \$250,000 or more (49 U.S.C. 5124). Hazardous materials include explosives, compressed gases, flammable liquids and solids, oxidizers, poisons, corrosives and radioactive materials. Examples: Paints, lighter fluid, fireworks, tear gases, oxygen bottles, and radio-pharmaceuticals. There are special exceptions for small quantities (up to 70 ounces total) of medicinal and toiletry articles carried in your luggage and certain smoking materials carried on your person. ## Persons Needing Special Assistance

Holiday Vacations does not provide personal attendant services. Any disability requiring special attention should be reported to us at the time you make your reservation. We will make reasonable attempts to accommodate special needs, but we are not responsible for any denial of services by carriers, hotels, restaurants, and other independent suppliers. Travelers requiring assistance must be accompanied by a companion who is capable of and totally responsible for providing the necessary assistance.

## Children On Tour

Children traveling on tour must be at least eight years old and accompanied by an adult.

## Reservation Changes

or extended hotel stays or for other eligible components of the tour should be made prior to the final payment date. A non-refundable processing fee of \$50 per person will apply for any change requested prior to the final payment date and \$100 per person for any change requested on or after the final payment date. These fees are in addition to any costs or penalties from suppliers.

## Gratuities

Tips for all the included features of your tour (baggage handling, included meals, etc.) will be taken care of by your Tour Director. Tips for meals on your own or for other services are at your discretion. Customary tips for the Tour Director & Driver are on a voluntary basis and given individually. Gratuity guidelines will be provided with your tour documents.

## Activity Level

To help evaluate if a tour is right for you, Holiday Vacations has designed a rating system that identifies a tour's average activity level.

Activity levels have five ranks ranging from "Relaxing" to "Active". On a tour rated "Relaxing," expect to climb some stairs, navigate slight slopes, stand for reasonable periods of time, and walk over relatively level conditions. On a tour rated "Active", expect a high activity level with challenging conditions, lots of walking, uneven surfaces, and possibly high altitudes.



Holiday Vacations guests must be able to navigate airports with their own luggage. Airport personnel can provide wheelchair assistance upon request. Guests must also be able to handle their own carry-on bags on airplanes, on and off motorcoaches, and to and from hotel rooms. Checked luggage will be delivered to and from guests' hotel rooms on their behalf.

If a guest requires mobility assistance, they must be accompanied by an able companion who is totally responsible for providing the guest's necessary assistance. Holiday Vacations does not provide personal attendant services.

All activity level ratings are relative to each guest's individual levels of fitness and mobility. Holiday Vacations is unable to determine your travel health and fitness level. Please consult your doctor when evaluating your ability to travel.

## Insurance

Holiday Vacations recognizes the value and importance of travel insurance for our customers. We offer an optional Travel Protection Plan, which helps provide coverage for Trip Cancellation, Trip Interruption, emergency Medical and Emergency Evacuation/Repatriation, Trip Delay, Baggage Delay and more. An insurance brochure will be mailed with your first statement or may be requested in advance. If you would like to purchase the insurance, please contact Holiday Vacations. Processing fees for a voluntary change in airport departure or for other requested changes are not covered by this type of insurance. ## Solo Travelers

Holiday Vacations welcomes solo travelers. We will try to assist in arranging a roommate for any person wishing to share accommodations at the double occupancy tour rate. Should a shared arrangement not be available, the single price applies.

## Triple & Quad

These accommodations are usually in rooms with two double beds. A rollaway bed or cot is subject to availability on a request basis.

**Real ID Domestic Tours:** Effective for all domestic flights with a start or finish after **October 1, 2021**, all passengers 18 years of age and older must carry a **REAL ID** compliant driver's license or another federally approved ID such as a Passport, active Military ID or Global Entry card.

**Passport Required (FOR INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL)** Your Passport must be valid for **6 months** from the end date of your tour. It is Holiday Vacations' policy that all tours traveling outside of the United States require a valid U.S. Passport in the form of a Passport book. Passport cards are not advised for any Holiday Vacations tour traveling outside of the United States.

## Travel to Canada

Even with a required Passport, Canada considers people with certain criminal records as inadmissible. Canada classifies DWI's, DUI's and OWI's as felonies and considers a person inadmissible if they have one of these in the past 10-15 years on their record. Other offenses such as multiple DUIs, theft or assault can bar entry even if committed decades ago. Additional pieces of luggage will be handled for you at hotels at \$6 per bag, per day or at the cost specified for certain tours. Though every effort will be made to safeguard your baggage, Holiday Vacations accepts no liability for loss or damage.

## Nantucket Whaling Museum

The masterful Nantucket Whaling Museum showcases marine life and history in seamless exhibits including the monumental addition from its 2005 restoration, a 46-foot-long skeleton of a sperm whale that hangs from the ceiling. Enjoy the historic architecture and immersive atmosphere that captures the essence of Nantucket's history intersecting with nature over the past 200 years.



## The Breakers Mansion

Visit Rhode Island's most popular attraction. Stroll The Breakers Mansion in Newport, originally a summer home to the wealthy Vanderbilt family. Built in 1895, the massive mansion and grounds (worth \$12.8 million today) is styled in Neo Italian Renaissance architecture. It showcases American history through the Vanderbilt family's legacy as railroad tycoons and the enormous wealth generated during the "Gilded Age" of the industrial revolution.



## Providence Boat Tour

Even locals learn something new about Rhode Island's capital city when they tour the Providence waterways. We get to know the Providence River including Waterplace Park, the Riverwalk, the Providence Industrial Harbor, and the Fox Point Hurricane Barrier while enjoying historical, nautical, and architectural highlights as we glide down the river on this relaxing, educational boat tour.
